

BRUSH MISER



THE BRUSH MISER is a valuable new product available to the circuit board production shop.
(See also our brochure on the **CENTRALISER**.)

Its primary function is to care for your brushing and deburring machine whilst saving you time and money. Free standing it can be placed in front of any manufacture machine.

Designed to precede a brushing machine it positions panels before entry. As panels approach the brushing machine they are sensed by a photo-cell which activates air cylinders fitted under the unit. Boards are automatically placed in sequence to the right hand side, centre and left hand sides of the conveyor. This ensures full and even brush wear. Because brushes differ slightly in length, an adjustment is included on the unit which can be set each time a new brush is fitted. When correctly set, the entire length of the brush will be used, keeping the brush parallel and increasing brush life.

N.B. The Brush Miser is not capable of simultaneously handling two or more boards across the conveyor width.

This is what you can expect from your **BRUSH MISER**: (1) Greatly increased brush life; (2) You may never need to dress your brush again; (3) Wear on anvil or billy rollers is almost eliminated and general wear and tear on your machine is greatly reduced.
